Full terms and conditions:

These Terms and Conditions are the Lottery Rules. By entering the lottery entrants agree to be bound by these rules.

The Lottery

- The Newcastle Carers Lottery is administered by Newcastle Carers, 135-139 Shields Road, Byker, Newcastle upon Tyne, NE6 1DN; Charity Registration No: 1145373 and Company Registration No: 7869359.
- Newcastle Carers is registered with the City of Newcastle Upon Tyne under Part 5 of Schedule 11 of the Gambling Act 2005. The Promotor of the Newcastle Carers Lottery is Katie Dodd, Chief Executive, Newcastle Carers, at the above address.

The Prize Fund

- 50% of the funds collected for each draw will be used as a prize fund; all profits will be used for Newcastle Carers charitable purposes to support services for local carers.
- Prizes and the amount contributed to the charity will vary depending on the number of entries.
- Distribution of the prize fund:
1st prize is 70% of the prize fund, 2nd prize is 20% of the prize fund and 3rd prize is 10% of the prize fund. So, with 500 entries the prize fund would be £250 per month, 1st prize would be £175, 2nd prize would be £50 and 3rd prize would be £25.
- We reserve the right to review the prize levels from time to time, by changing the number of prizes or the prize levels; we will, however, not change the overall prize fund which will remain 50% of the amount collected. If we make such changes we will give notice through our newsletter, on our website and in Newcastle Carers Centre.

Entering the Lottery

- Entrants must be resident in Great Britain and aged 16 years or over.
- Entrants must complete an entry form and payment must be received and cleared before entry to the draw.
- An entry form can be completed at any time and will run for 12 months.
- All lottery entry sales are final and no refunds shall be made at any time. All entrants acknowledge that their payment of £1 per entry per month to enter

the lottery does not guarantee that they will win any prize.

- All entrants are solely responsible for providing Newcastle Carers with their accurate and up-to-date contact details and Newcastle Carers will be in no way liable for any failure or inability to contact any entrant due to any errors, omissions or inaccuracies in the contact details that the entrant has provided. In the event that an entrant changes their contact details, they will be solely responsible for advising Newcastle Carers of the changes.

Monthly Prize Draws

- The first draw will take place on the Monday following 150 entries being received, and then monthly thereafter. We will seek to continue to carry out the draw on a Monday but may vary the draw date if circumstances require us to.
- Winners will be selected at random using a random number generator.
- Prizes will be paid by cheque and will be posted to the address on the entrant's application form, unless they have notified us of a change of address.
- If a prize is unclaimed – for example, if a winner's cheque is not cashed - we will make every effort to contact the winner and make payment, but after a period of 12 months from the winning draw date, if the prize has still not been claimed, the prize will become null and void and the funds will be contributed to our charitable purposes.
- We will publish the results of each lottery on our website and in our newsletter and display them in the centre; this will include the names of the winners of the draw unless they have requested anonymity. We will also publish the amount collected for the draw, the prize levels and the amount contributed to our charitable purposes.

Renewal

- Two months before an entry is due for renewal we will send the entrant a reminder to renew. We will contact them according to their preferences on the entry form.
- We will send further reminders until the entrant either renews their entry or lets us know that they do not wish to renew their entry.

Disputes

- We will always act in good faith and with fairness

when administering the draw. If a dispute arises or a situation arises that has not been envisaged, the decision of Newcastle Carers as the administrators will be final.

- Newcastle Carers shall not be liable to the entrant for any loss or damage suffered or arising from:
 - o any delays or failures in the postal service or other delivery methods used by Newcastle Carers or the entrant from time to time;
 - o any delays or failures in any software or other systems used by Newcastle Carers for the administration of the lottery;
 - o any delays or failures in the banking system used by Newcastle Carers or the entrant;
 - o any refusal by Newcastle Carers to accept registration of an individual as an entrant or the cancellation of an entrant;
 - o any failure to enter a chance into the draw.
- Nothing within these terms and conditions shall create or should be construed as creating any form of contract between any entrant and Newcastle Carers.

Right to Cancel

- We reserve the right to end the lottery at any time or to give notice of our intention to end the lottery at some point in the future; if such circumstances arise

we will repay any unused contributions that have not yet been entered in a monthly draw.

Data Protection

- The Newcastle Carers Lottery records are kept independently of our other records. We will only contact entrants if they have won a prize, they are due to renew their membership or if we intend making any changes to the lottery.
- If at any time an entrant wants us to remove their details from the Newcastle Carers Lottery records they should let us know, however entrants should be aware that once we have done this we will not be able to notify them of any winnings.

General

Each entrant should retain a copy of these Terms and Conditions for their reference. Copies can be requested from Newcastle Carers at any time.
